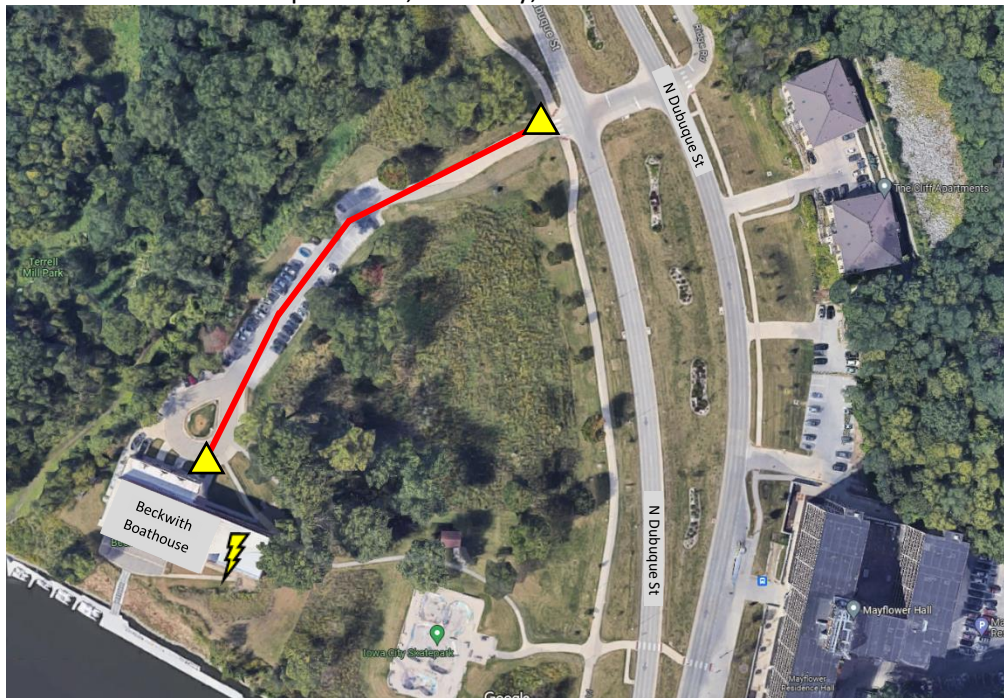

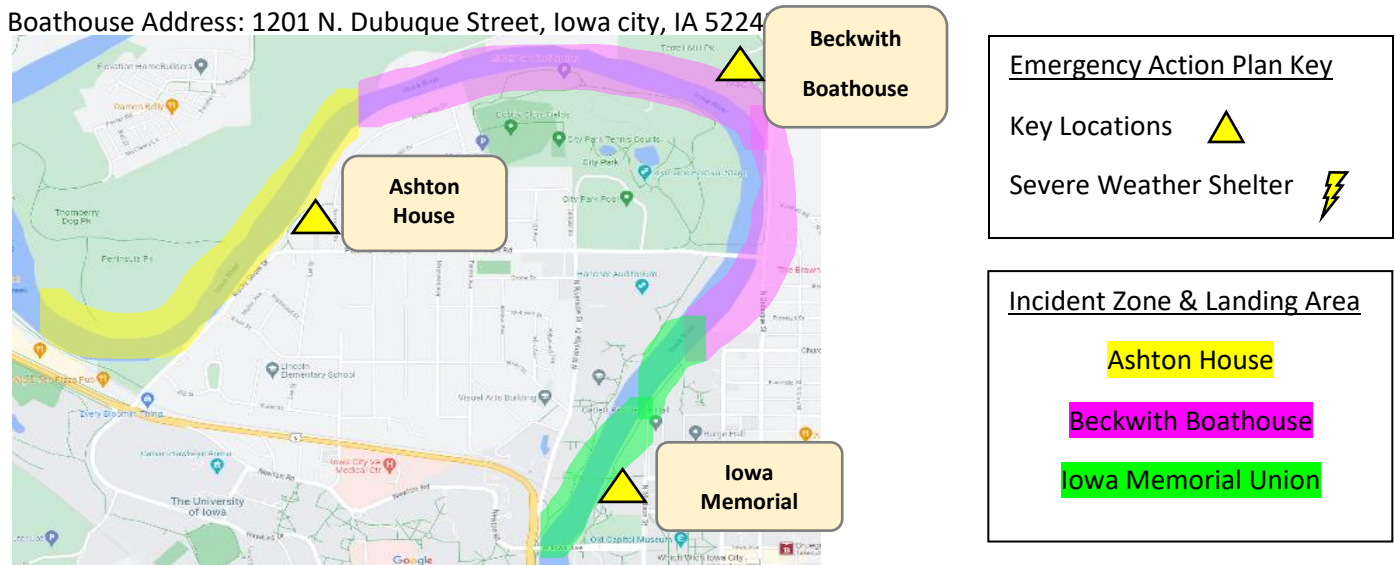

Role of First Responders

1. A Coach will provide immediate care of injured/ill student-athlete and retrieve emergency equipment.
2. If warranted, Coach can call 911 directly to initiate EMS.
 - a. The Caller will relay pertinent information: their name, location, specific directions, telephone number, number of injured individuals, care given, other information as requested.
 - b. If an ambulance is required, the meeting location will be determined by the nearest landing area to the incident (see map):
3. The student-athlete(s) will be taken to shore at the appropriate site in either the boat shell or the Coach's launch. The Athletic Trainer will meet the injured/ill student-athlete to assist in medical care and transportation.

Venue Directions

The Caller will instruct EMS to report to the appropriate landing area based on the incident site. Depending on available personnel, individuals will be stationed at key locations to help direct EMS.

- **Ashton House: 820 Park Road:** If an incident occurs between Pump House turn and the upstream terminus at The Heartland Inn.
 - EMS can follow the running path off Park Road directly behind the home and access the shoreline landing area.
 - **Beckwith Boathouse: 1201 N. Dubuque Street:** If an incident occurs between Hancher Footbridge and the Pump House.
 - EMS will enter the parking lot off North Dubuque Street and park in front of second garage door of the main building. EMS will access the dock/landing area through the second garage door boat bay.
- **Iowa Memorial Union: 125 N. Madison Street:** If an incident occurs between the Iowa Avenue Bridge and the Hancher Footbridge.
 - EMS will park in the South side lot of the IMU off N. Madison Street and follow the sidewalk to the back of the building. Landing area is along the shore across from the Amphitheater.

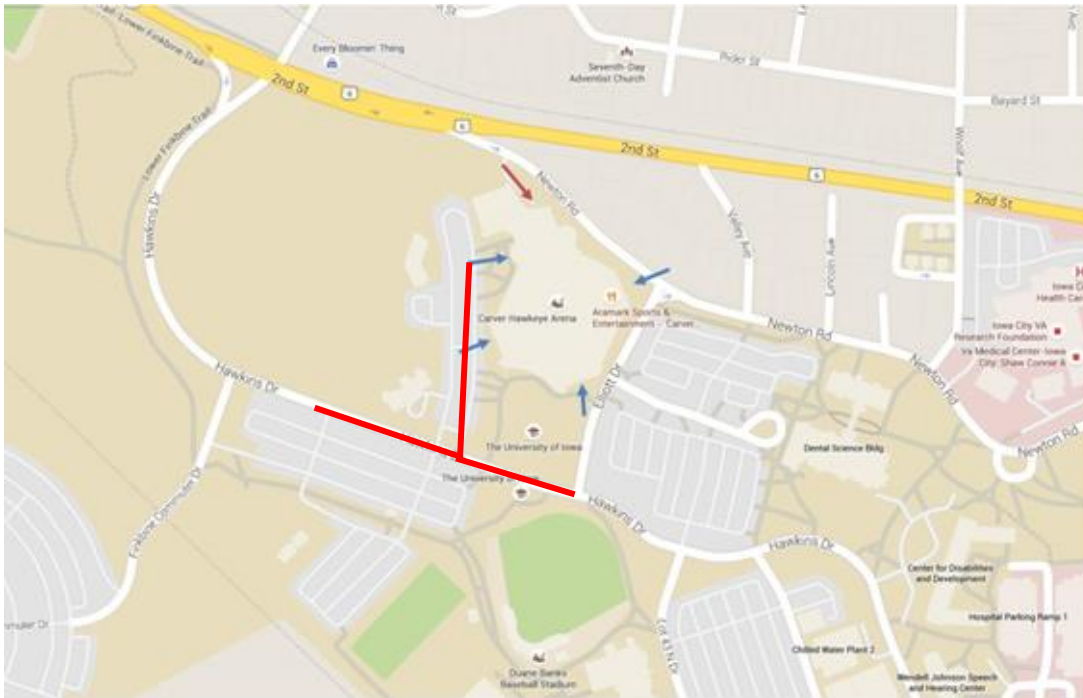

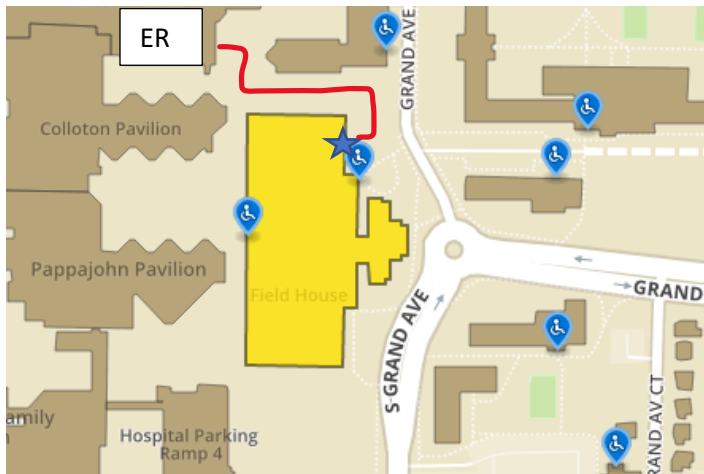

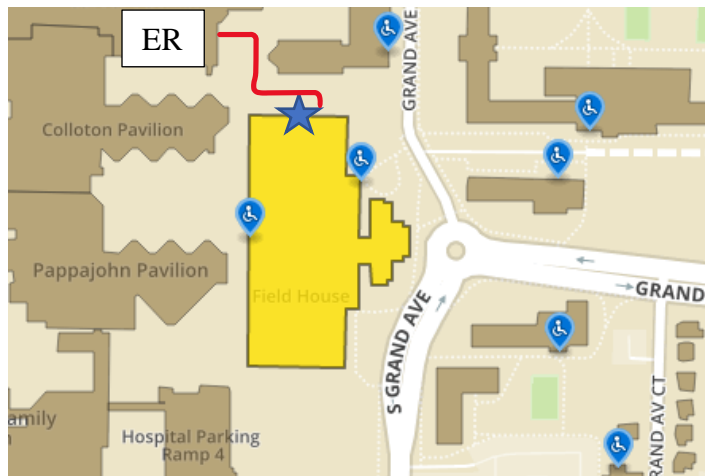

1. Staff or designee (Caller) calls 911 (on cell or 9-911 on landline) to activate EMS. This person will instruct EMS to report to the club house.
2. The Caller has responsibility of flagging down EMS at the entrance of the club house. Other staff have responsibility to clear bystanders from the victim. If the patient is on the course, club house personnel will escort EMS to the victim.
3. A qualified emergency rescuer provides emergency care until EMS personnel arrive. The rescuer then provides pertinent information to EMS (cause of injury, vital signs, treatment rendered, medical history) and assists with emergency care as needed. When a concussion or spine injury is involved, the AT in charge (if present) will direct EMS as appropriate.
4. If an athlete is involved, staff AT or a designee will accompany the athlete to the hospital and direct the ER providers to contact the team physician and keep the Sport supervisor informed.
5. If an athlete is involved, staff AT or a designee will accompany the athlete to the hospital and direct the ER providers to contact the team physician and keep the Associate Director informed.
6. If an athlete is involved, the staff AT will contact the Associate Director, Director of Athletic Training, Head Coach, and parents/guardians/family within hours to provide appropriate information and status.
7. If an athlete is involved, the staff AT will complete a SIMS injury report and notify the sport administrator within 24 hours of the incident.
