Role of First Responders

1. A Coach will provide immediate care of injured/ill student-athlete and retrieve emergency equipment.
2. If warranted, Coach can call 911 directly to initiate EMS.
 - a. The Caller will relay pertinent information: their name, location, specific directions, telephone number, number of injured individuals, care given, other information as requested.
 - b. If an ambulance is required, the meeting location will be determined by the nearest landing area to the incident (see map):
3. The student-athlete(s) will be taken to shore at the appropriate site in either the boat shell or the Coach's launch. The Athletic Trainer will meet the injured/ill student-athlete to assist in medical care and transportation.

Venue Directions

The Caller will instruct EMS to report to the appropriate landing area based on the incident site. Depending on available personnel, individuals will be stationed at key locations to help direct EMS.

- **Ashton House: 820 Park Road:** If an incident occurs between Pump House turn and the upstream terminus at The Heartland Inn.
 - EMS can follow the running path off Park Road directly behind the home and access the shoreline landing area.
 - **Beckwith Boathouse: 1201 N. Dubuque Street:** If an incident occurs between Hancher Footbridge and the Pump House.
 - EMS will enter the parking lot off North Dubuque Street and park in front of second garage door of the main building. EMS will access the dock/landing area through the second garage door boat bay.
- **Iowa Memorial Union: 125 N. Madison Street:** If an incident occurs between the Iowa Avenue Bridge and the Hancher Footbridge.
 - EMS will park in the South side lot of the IMU off N. Madison Street and follow the sidewalk to the back of the building. Landing area is along the shore across from the Amphitheater.
